Getting to Queen's University

Getting to Queen's is relatively easy, but the following information may be of some use to those of you who have never visited the university before:

From the Airport:

There are two airports serving Belfast: Belfast International Airport (BFS) and Belfast City Airport (BHD)

- Belfast International Airport is situated about 20 miles from the city centre.
- A taxi directly to the University (or the city centre) will cost around £30.
- There is also a **shuttle bus**, the Airport Express 300, which operates a 24 hour service between the airport and Belfast with buses departing every 15 minutes for the majority of the day on weekdays, with reduced frequencies at off peak times and weekends. The bus leaves from the bus stop located opposite the terminal exit and goes to the Belfast Europa Bus Centre, adjacent to the Europa Hotel on Great Victoria Street. The shuttle costs approximately £7 single and £10 return. The journey should take approximately 30-40 minutes subject to traffic conditions. - Belfast City Airport is situated about 5 miles from the City Centre.
- A **taxi** to the University will cost around £8.
- There is also a **shuttle bus**, the Airport Express 600 operates every 20 minutes from outside the airport to the Belfast Europa Bus Centre adjacent to the Europa Hotel, on Great Victoria Street. The Airport Express 600, operates between 0530 and 2205, and costs £2.00 single and £3.00 return. For further information and timetable details <u>click</u> here.

Travel from the Bus Station to Queen's University:

If you take either of the airport shuttles and arrive at the Belfast Europa Bus Centre, (Europa) you can take a taxi onwards to the University. A taxi fare will cost approximately £4

There are also regular bus services to the University. Leave the bus station through the main exit onto Great Victoria Street (you will see the Europa Hotel to your left), cross the road and you will find a bus stop. The 8A, 8B, and 8C all go to Queen's University (there is a bus stop directly outside the main building). Fares to Queen's are £1.

You can also walk to the University from the bus station. Just exit the bus station on to Great Victoria Street, turn right, and follow the road for about 10 minutes until you reach the University. See the map at www.qub.ac.uk/home/TheUniversity/Location/Maps/Belfast/
