In keeping with the traditions of the conference, papers that are concerned with the development and revision of contemporaneous perceptions of inspiration, imagination and vision, and current scholarship in related areas, are welcome.

Papers on, but not restricted to, the following topics are welcome:

Inspiration: divine, secular, literary.

Imagination: deployment, expression, conceptualisation, representation.

Vision: spiritual, prophetic, political, physical, metaphysical.

The conference will be held in UCC's historical Quadrangle from April 15th - 17th 2011.
